# Privacy Notice for Alumni Relations and Development Team

## Privacy Statement

The General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 (and, where applicable, EU GDPR) governs the way that organisations use personal data. Personal data is information relating to an identifiable living individual.

## How your data is collected

- x If you studied at the University, we process your personal data during your time as a student as outlined in our [Student & Applicant Privacy Notice](#).
- x If you are a supporter of the University we store and process data that you provide to us as outlined when you provided us this information e.g. when attending an event.
- x We may also collect, store and process personal data derived from publicly available sources e.g. LinkedIn, Twitter, Companies House etc.
- x Alumni can manage and update their own details via our website. By doing so you are providing consent to update our records and communicate with you using that information. Any update provided in this way will overwrite previous contact details and communication will continue with your previous preferences and new contact details unless otherwise updated.

## The data we hold about you and how it is used

Generally, the processing of your personal data is to improve your experience and engagement with the University.

The Alumni Relations and Development Team will contact you through the channels to which you have provided your details.
